2020 Fund-A-Need In Action

Your trust and investment in the Foundation's virtual fundraising effort gave our Grants Committee a lot to work with — and we've begun making decisions on distributing the over \$130,000 generated during our Virtual Winesong. Below are some of the incredible projects we've funded with more to follow as we work with our healthcare partners to identify the current needs in our coastal community and leverage your contributions to enhancing the health and wellness, safety and accessibility of healthcare in our service district.

Comptche Volunteer Fire Department: new pagers for all First Responders and AV equipment for COVID-19 Safety Training.

Albion Volunteer Fire Department: Upgrade of the radio repeaters that connect communication during emergencies.

Mendocino Coast Clinic: Fetal monitors and an ultrasound machine for their reproductive & obstetrics services.

Mendocino Coast Children's Fund: Funds for a bilingual Resource Brochure and to distribute air purifier kits to families affected by wildfire smoke and winter heating that affects indoor air quality.

Our Fund-A-Need disbursements continue to fulfill our broader mission to fund our healthcare partner organizations while they respond to the challenges that affect our most vulnerable here on the coast. This ensures your contributions have an Immediate, meaningful impact.
