Welcome and Introductions: Thais called meeting to order at 16:04. Introductions were made for the attendees

Thais reviewed the Community Health Improvement Plan history.

Community Health Needs Assessment was completed

Results can be found on the Healthy Mendocino website.

A lot has happened since the initial study: (fires, mill site shut down (2001), fishing industry hits, cannabis industry hit)

The five priorities areas are: Mental Health, Poverty, Housing, Childhood Trauma, Family Wellness (including Childhood Obesity)

Thais reminded the team of the Healthy Mendocino Summit on March 8th in Willits - 9:30 - 12:30 (Willits Community Center?) and encouraged all to carpool. Thais gave a brief overview of what to expect at the summit.

We have three years to impact our communities. The final community health improvement plan review will be due June 1, 2020.

Team discussed a key strategy: Expand or build relationships/communication with people in the community.

A suggestion was made to market crisis center for all people, not just medi-cal beneficiaries.

Reviewed Goal 1 and the 3 corresponding objectives. Identified the following trainings that would be helpful for the coast: Mental Health First Aid; ASIST (MHSA).

Thais provided information on some of the other action teams including an 8 week course being offered through the West Company on Money Management.

Last Letter exhibit - put on an exhibit of last letters from people who have completed suicide.
